House Votes

HF 2329 – Fetal Tissue Donation Ban

This bill would have banned the donation of fetal tissue for critical and lifesaving research – but only for women who have had an abortion. Passed 56 - 43; 3/9/2016. Planned Parenthood opposed. The bill was not considered by the Senate.

HF 2460 – Family Planning Program Attack

Final passage of the House version of the Health and Human Services (HHS) budget. The House version included a provision that would have eliminated the Iowa Family Planning Network (IFPN), a Medicaid program that provides family planning and reproductive health services annually to 32,000 Iowans in need, and in its place, created a state-funded program that would exclude abortion providers and would cost the state an additional \$3 million to fund without federal match dollars. Passed 56 - 42; 4/20/2016. Planned Parenthood opposed.

H-8230 – Family Planning Program Restoration

Amendment H-8230 to HF 2460. H-8230, proposed by Representative Wessel-Kroeschell, would have reinstated the IFPN program in the House HHS budget. Failed 42 - 57; 4/19/2016. Planned Parenthood supported.

Senate Vote

S-5172 – Family Planning Program Attack

Amendment S-5172 to amendment S-5158 to HF 2460. S-5172 by Senator Rozenboom would have reverted to the House's language ending the IFPN program in the HHS budget. Failed 25 - 25; 4/22/2016. Planned Parenthood opposed.

HF 2460 – Family Planning Program Restoration

Final passage of the HHS budget bill which left the IFPN program intact. Passed 27 - 23; 4/22/2016. Planned Parenthood supported.

IOWA LEGISLATIVE SESSION RECAP

As expected, this legislative session was tough. We saw anti-choice lawmakers use a variety of futile and unconstitutional tactics to attack reproductive health and rights.

We faced attempts to defund PPHeartland, restrict and ban abortion, limit youth's access to evidence-based sexual health education,

and more. We even saw lawmakers attempt to hijack a bill that would have increased legal protections for transgender lowans and maliciously amend it to outlaw abortion. **But because of dedicated advocates like you, we prevailed against each of these attacks so that lowans continue to have access to high-quality health care including safe, legal abortion.**

Day on the Hill participants championed continued funding for both PPHeartland and the Iowa Family Planning Network (IFPN), a Medicaid program providing family planning services to people up to 300% of poverty. That same week, a Des Moines Register poll showed 74% of lowans support state funding for PPHeartland. This strength in numbers was crucial when the House did in fact attempt to do away with the IFPN and defund PPHeartland in their proposed Health and Human Services budget. Thanks to a one-vote pro-family planning

majority in the Senate, this funding was restored in final negotiations, but these votes underscored how urgently we need supporters like you to help hold the line.

In addition, advocates rallied to defeat a bill that would have banned the donation of fetal tissue and its use in medical research. Although PPHeartland does not participate in fetal tissue donation, we joined the Iowa Board of Regents and University of Iowa in opposing this bill because of the disastrous limitations it would have placed on life-saving medical research.

While we are thrilled that none of this harmful legislation passed this session, it was disappointing to see legislators pass over several progressive policy initiatives, including bills to make oral contraceptives more accessible, and to improve the quality of sex education in public schools. However, you've helped lay the groundwork to take these bills up again next session. **We are grateful for you and your advocacy, and we know we can count on you to keep up the fight!**
